

MOTOR VEHICLES:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. SCOUTS HAVE RIGHT OF WAY.
3. SPEED LIMIT 15 MPH.
4. MOTOR VEHICLES AND BSA CAMPING DO NOT MIX. MOVE YOUR VEHICLE TO A DESIGNATED PARKING AREA IMMEDIATELY AFTER UNLOADING.
5. PARK IN DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS ONLY.
6. RESPECT PARKING BARRICADES.
7. DO NOT BLOCK ROADS. KEEP ALL ROADS CLEAR FOR EMERGENCY AND SERVICE VEHICLES.
8. VEHICLES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE PARADE GROUNDS.
9. LIMIT VEHICLE USE WHEN ROADS ARE MUDDY.
10. LEAVE NO TRACE.

CAMPSITES:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. A SCOUT IS TRUSTWORTHY.
3. RESPECT THE SHELTER AND LATRINE IN YOUR CAMPSITE AND OTHER CAMPSITES.
4. SUMMER-CAMP WOOD-TENT-PLATFORMS SHOULD NOT BE USED WITHOUT PERMISSION.
5. PLATFORMS MUST BE STACKED AWAY FROM CONTACT WITH SOIL AND WITH TOP UP SO AS NOT TO COLLECT LEAVES AND DEBRIS.
6. CAMPING IS NOT PERMITTED ON PARADE GROUNDS
7. LEAVE NO TRACE.

FIRES:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. A SCOUT IS OBEDIENT.
3. OBSERVE BSA FIRE SAFETY RULES.
4. USE EXISTING FIRE RINGS ONLY.
5. DO NOT DIG PITS FOR FIRES.
6. EXTINGUISH YOUR FIRE PROPERLY WHEN NOT ATTENDED.
7. DEAD WOOD ON THE GROUND MAY BE USED FOR FIREWOOD.
8. PREVENT WILDFIRES. REPORT ANY UNATTENDED FIRES OR SMOKE TO THE RANGER IMMEDIATELY!
9. LEAVE NO TRACE.

TRASH:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. A SCOUT IS CLEAN.
3. PICK UP LITTER WHEN YOU FIND IT.
4. CARRY YOUR TRASH HOME, DO NOT LEAVE IT HERE.
5. DUMPSTERS ARE NOT AVAILABLE.
6. LEAVE NO TRACE.

Rule # 1: *DO NO HARM.*

WATER:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. A SCOUT IS HELPFUL.
3. WATER IN CAMPSITES IS AVAILABLE APRIL 1ST THROUGH OCTOBER 30TH.
4. A YEAR AROUND FREEZE-PROOF WATER HYDRANT IS AVAILABLE NEXT TO THE ROAD NEAR THE ARCHERY RANGE.
5. CHECK WITH THE RANGER BEFORE TURNING WATER ON TO ANY STRUCTURE.
6. REPORT WATER LEAKS.
7. LEAVE NO TRACE.

LATRINES & TOILETS:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. A SCOUT IS CLEAN.
3. KEEP LATRINES CLEAN.
4. DO NOT PUT TRASH IN LATRINE PITS.
5. CLOSE LIDS AFTER USE TO HELP CONTROL INSECTS.
6. DO NOT USE FLUSH TOILETS IF WATER IS OFF. FLUSH FIRST, FLUSH LAST.
7. LEAVE NO TRACE.

TREES, PLANTS, & WILDLIFE:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. A SCOUT IS KIND.
3. DO NOT CUT OR DESTROY ANY TREES OR PLANTS, EVEN IF IT HAS THORNS OR SPINES.
4. KEEP YOUR DISTANCE FROM ANY WILDLIFE.
5. REMEMBER THAT THIS IS THEIR HOME. YOU ARE THE VISITOR HERE
6. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO CAPTURE OR KILL SNAKES. REPORT SIGHTINGS TO THE RANGER
7. LEAVE NO TRACE.

WORTH RANCH BOUNDARIES:

1. DO NO HARM.
2. A SCOUT IS COURTEOUS.
3. DO NOT CROSS ANY FENCE LINES ONTO NON-CAMP PROPERTY.
4. LIVESTOCK GRAZES ON CERTAIN PARTS OF WR. CLOSE ALL GATES BEHIND YOU.
5. REPORT ANY DOWNED FENCES TO THE RANGER.
6. RESPECT ANY "OFF LIMITS" SIGNS FOR YOUR OWN PROTECTION
7. LEAVE NO TRACE.

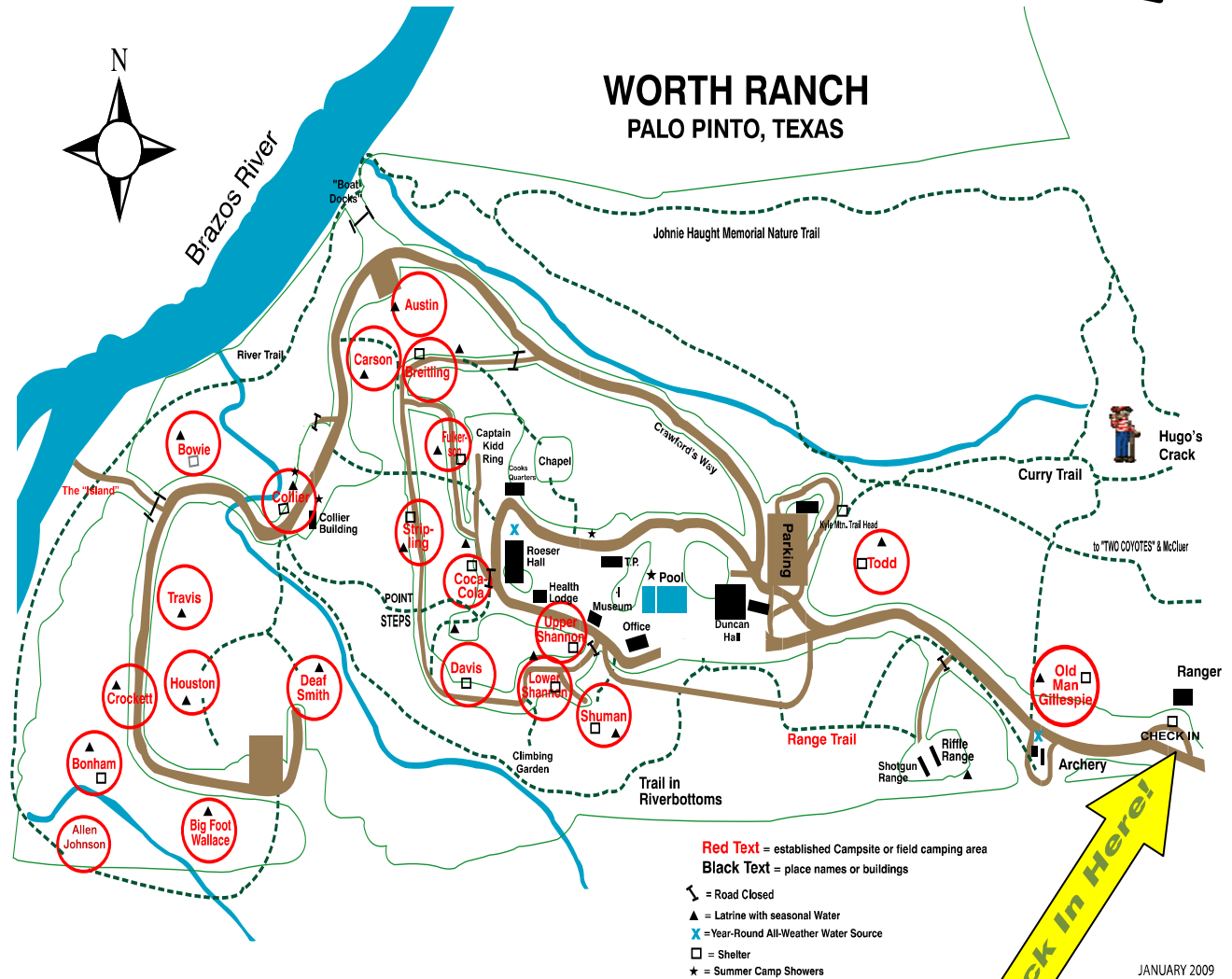
BSA GUIDELINES

MUST BE FOLLOWED AT ALL TIMES

- ★ ALL VISITORS MUST CHECK IN WITH THE RANGER BEFORE ENTERING CAMP.
- ★ SCOUT TROOPS MUST HAVE A YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINED LEADER IN CAMP AT ALL TIMES.
- ★ CANOE GROUPS MUST HAVE RECEIVED TRAINING IN SAFE SWIM DEFENSE AND SAFETY AFLOAT.
- ★ CUB PACKS MUST HAVE A BALOO TRAINED LEADER IN CAMP PRIOR TO ADMITTANCE. NO CUB WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER CAMP UNTIL BALOO LEADER ARRIVES.
- ★ EQUIPMENT WILL NOT BE ISSUED UNTIL PROOF OF REQUIRED TRAINING HAS BEEN PROVIDED.
- ★ DO NOT CROSS ANY FENCES ON THE NORTH OR SOUTH SIDES OF CAMP. WE DO NOT HAVE PERMISSION TO ENTER THESE PROPERTIES. IF YOU DO, YOU WILL BE TRESPASSING.
- ★ ANY ISSUES WITH ANOTHER UNIT SHOULD BE DEALT WITH IN A SCOUTLIKE MANNER. SHOULD THIS FAIL TO SOLVE THE ISSUE IT SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE RANGER'S ATTENTION.
- ★ ANY BUILDING USED BY YOUR GROUP SHOULD BE CLEANED BEFORE YOU LEAVE.
- ★ DO NOT ENTER ANY BUILDINGS NOT RESERVED BY YOUR GROUP.
- ★ ANY DAMAGE TO WORTH RANCH PROPERTY SHOULD BE REPORTED TO THE RANGER IMMEDIATELY.
